
## JOIN REV. DR. DAVID USHER ON A FASCINATING EXPLORATION OF UNITARIANISM IN BRITAIN

British Unitarianism enjoys a rich history spanning almost 350 years, and its churches are amongst the country's finest examples of nonconformist architecture. British Unitarians are known for the warmth of their welcome, especially to their American counterparts.

Our journey begins in Southeast England attending the annual FUSE Festival (Festival of Unitarians in the South East). We'll spend the weekend taking part in interesting and engaging workshops and sessions based around the themes of spirituality, community, social action, creativity and music, as well as having ample time to mingle and socialize with our British UU cousins.

Leaving the southeast, we head north to Oxford, city of dreaming spires and ancient seat of learning. A walking tour of the city center




Our travels will take us to magnificent stately homes, friendly country pubs, fascinating museums and gorgeous countryside - and all with a backdrop of Unitarian history and tradition. Your guide will be the Rev. Dr. David Usher, a graduate of Oxford University with 35 years as a UU minister in both England and the US, as well as previous experience leading several tours. The Reverend David Usher is uniquely qualified to introduce you to British

Unitarianism.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 17<sup>TH</sup> - Departure from your chosen gateway city. **OVERNIGHT:** PLANE

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18<sup>TH</sup> - Your arrival at London Heathrow Airport will be met for the transfer to our hotel in Royal Windsor. After time to unpack and rest up from the overnight flight, there will be an orientation meeting to introduce you to the tour and the neighborhood of your hotel. This evening we'll gather for drinks before a welcome dinner at the hotel. (D) OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 19<sup>TH</sup> - After a leisurely breakfast we will drive down to southeast England to attend the FUSE Festival (location for 2021 to be finalized). (B, L, D) OVERNIGHT: FUSE

Saturday, February 20th - A full day at FUSE. (B, L, D) Overnight: FUSE

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 21<sup>st</sup> - This morning we attend the services and then, this afternoon, we set off for Oxford, arriving in time to check in at our hotel and freshen up before we gather for dinner. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: OXFORD


MONDAY, FEBRUARY 22<sup>ND</sup> - This morning we explore the beautiful city of Oxford, astride the River Thames, its historic buildings clustered within easy walking distance around the medieval core. The real treasure is the architectural beauty of Oxford University and its diverse buildings, many of which date back to the 13th and 14th centuries. We'll stop at Harris Manchester College (originally founded as a college for Unitarian students) and end our tour with a visit to Christchurch, the largest of the Oxford colleges and the home of the city's cathedral. The afternoon is free for individual exploration. For dinner why not sample a local restaurant or pub (David knows a few from his student days here!). (B) OVERNIGHT: OXFORD



Tuesday, February 23<sup>RD</sup> - This morning we visit nearby Blenheim Palace, the ancestral home of the Dukes of Marlborough and the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill. After time for lunch in the neighboring village of Woodstock, we continue to Shakespeare's town of Stratford-upon-Avon. After an early dinner at the hotel, we will attend a performance in the Royal Shakespeare Theatre (this could possibly be a matinee performance - the schedule has not yet been published for February 2021). (B, D) Overnight: Stratford-upon-Avon

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 24<sup>TH</sup> - On the trail of the Bard of Avon this morning, we will begin with a visit to the Shakespeare Birthplace Museum. From here we will stroll along the bank of the river Avon to the Trinity Church. It was here that he was baptized, married and buried - although there is some dispute as to whether his remains are still there! The afternoon and evening are free to further explore the town. (B) OVERNIGHT: STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 25<sup>TH</sup> - Continuing north today, we head into the Midlands. We'll stop first in Knutsford, a charming town known



as the setting for Elizabeth Gaskell's novel *Cranford*. It was in Knutsford that Elizabeth married the Unitarian minister, William Gaskell. After time for lunch in the town, this afternoon we'll visit the Quarry Bank Mill at Styal, a living museum showing every aspect of the life of mill workers during the heyday of the industrial revolution. The Styal Mill and village were originally owned by the Greg family, prominent Unitarians in their day. We continue to our hotel in the Peak District National Park, an area of supreme natural beauty surrounded by the industrial midlands of England. Dinner is included this evening. **(B, D) OVERNIGHT: BUXTON** 

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 26<sup>TH</sup> - Our excursion today will first take us to visit the "plague village" of Eyam before we arrive at Chatsworth House, "The Palace of the Peaks." We'll begin with a tour of the house, which contains a boundless collection ranging from Old Master paintings to the geological specimens brought by the last Duke, and then have free time to have lunch and to stroll around the gardens. It is a very short distance through the park to the village of Great Hucklow, where we will visit the Old Unitarian Chapel and stop at the Nightingale Centre, before returning to our hotel. The evening is free in Buxton. (B) OVERNIGHT: BUXTON


SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 27<sup>th</sup> - Morning drive to London. After checking into our hotel and having time for lunch, David will lead a walking tour to visit John Wesley's House and Chapel; the latter was opened in 1778 and the crypt was converted into a museum in 1981. Wesley's house has

been restored to its original Georgian interior design and includes a number of personal effects, including his preaching gown. Bunhill Fields is just across the City Road with the graves of John Bunyan, Defoe and William Blake. The evening is free. **(B) OVERNIGHT:** LONDON

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 28<sup>TH</sup> - This morning we'll attend the service at the Newington Green Unitarian Church in London, where Mary Wollstonecraft was a member. Following the service, there will be time to mingle with the congregation and have lunch in a local cafe. The afternoon is free and this evening we will gather at the hotel for a farewell dinner. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: LONDON

MONDAY, MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup> - Transfers today to Heathrow Airport for returning flights to the US. (B) OVERNIGHT: HOME

Discover Europe, Ltd. reserves the right to substitute hotels, airlines, activities or excursions in response to changes in availability, local events or weather conditions, provided such substitutions do not adversely affect the overall quality of the tour. Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.
- 6. Conduct During the Tour: You are responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and the laws of the countries in your itinerary. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

### PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- 1. A deposit of \$500 must accompany this completed form (if it has not already been paid).
- 2. The remaining balance will be billed and payable 90 days prior to trip departure. A late fee of \$100 per person may be added to balances still outstanding 60 days prior to departure.

## TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS

Discover Europe makes every effort to guarantee that the published cost of your chosen tour will not change. However, we do reserve the right to make adjustments in the following circumstances:

1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months

- prior to trip departure.
- 2. Group size. Discover Europe tours are generally based on a group size of 15 participants. Should we end up with fewer than 15 people, Discover Europe will determine a course of action which may involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour with all the inclusions listed, or making adjustments in order to keep the cost the same.
- 3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.
- 4. Late registrations (received within 60 days of departure) may also incur extra fees and charges as discounted rates for hotels and airfares may no longer be available so close to departure. Participants will be made aware of any such charges before their registration is accepted.

#### REFUND POLICY

- 1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty per person.
- 2. Participants who withdraw fewer than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less the following cancellation penalties:
  - 90-61 days prior to departure: \$1000 per person
  - 60 31 days prior to departure: \$2000 per person
  - 30 or fewer days prior to departure: no refund
- Please note that the final payment becomes due upon receipt of the final invoice and will remain payable, as per the above schedule, if your cancellation is received after this.
- 4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.
- 5. Trip cancellation insurance is *not* included in your Discover Europe tour package. Discover Europe, Ltd., strongly advises that you purchase travel insurance for your upcoming trip. Information describing the services of a recommended travel insurance company will be made available to you upon registration.
- 6. All cancellation requests must be received in writing.
- There is no provision for refund for any activities missed due to the participant's absence once the tour has started.
- 8. Your place on this tour is not transferable.
