
Join fellow retired UU Ministers & Their Partners on a fascinating tour of Unitarianism in Britain

Hosted by Rev. David Usher May 24^{th} - June 3^{rd} 2018

British Unitarianism enjoys a rich history of almost 350 years, and its churches are amongst the country's finest examples of nonconformist architecture. British Unitarians are known for the warmth of their welcome, especially to their American counterparts.

Our journey begins in London, one of the world's leading capital cities and a hotbed of nonconformist activity in the 18th century. Sightseeing of the city not only includes well-known sights, but some lesser-known visits as well, including John Wesley's house and chapel in Bunhill Fields. There is also free time in the city to pursue individual interests.


Leaving London we head northwest to Oxford, city of dreaming spires and ancient seat of learning. A walking tour of the city center highlights the historic, architecturally stunning colleges. We have a special visit to Harris Manchester College, one of England's two Unitarian training colleges and also tour nearby Blenheim palace, the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill.



From Oxford we wend our way through the Cotswold Hills, meandering through the rolling landscape on our way to Bath. A morning at Glastonbury is spent exploring one of England's most important religious and mystical sites where early Christian and Arthurian myths blend to create a rich and moving visit. The afternoon can be spent hill-walking in the Mendips, or discovering the tiny cathedral city of Wells.

We'll spend two nights in the beautiful cathedral city of Salisbury, paying a visit to nearby Stonehenge and then head to Royal Windsor for our final night and farewell dinner celebration. Your guide will be the Rev Dr David Usher, a graduate of Oxford University with 35 years as

a UU minister in both England and the US, as well as previous experience leading several tours. The Reverend David Usher is uniquely qualified to introduce you to British Unitarianism. This spring, join fellow Unitarian Universalists on an English pilgrimage, visiting some of its finest churches, historic religious sites, and most beautiful cities and landscapes.

THURSDAY, MAY 24TH - Departure from your chosen US gateway city. OVERNIGHT: PLANE

FRIDAY, MAY 25TH - Your morning arrival at London Heathrow Airport will be met for the transfer to our city-center hotel. After time to unpack and rest up from the overnight flight, there will be an orientation meeting to introduce you to the tour and the neighborhood of your hotel. This evening we'll gather for drinks before a welcome dinner at the hotel. (D) OVERNIGHT: LONDON

SATURDAY, MAY 26TH - The day begins with a sightseeing tour of London designed to give newcomers an overview of this great city and reacquaint returning travelers to London's many charms. We'll start in the City of Westminster where our local guide introduces us to 1,000 years of English history. Continuing on, we'll view many of London's major monuments, from the Albert Memorial to St. Paul's Cathedral to Trafalgar Square, touring the city from Chelsea to Bloomsbury. We visit

John Wesley's House and Chapel; the latter was opened in 1778 and the crypt was converted into a museum in 1981. Wesley's house has been restored to its original Georgian interior design and includes a number of personal effects, including his preaching gown. Bunhill Fields is just across the City Road with the graves of John Bunyan, Defoe and William Blake. The rest of the afternoon and evening are free to make your own plans--visit the Tower of London and see the Crown Jewels, or take a stroll through the Tate Modern. This evening, we'll attend the theatre and you can choose to have a quick supper beforehand or wait to eat until after the show. (B) **OVERNIGHT: LONDON**

Sunday, May 27^m - This morning we travel to Hampstead in north London to attend the service at the Hampstead Unitarian Church. Following time to mingle with the congregation, we'll head to Oxford, stopping along the way for lunch at a country pub. We'll visit Blenheim Palace, the ancestral home of the Dukes of Marlborough and the birthplace of Sir

Winston Churchill, and then drive the short distance to our Oxford hotel, arriving in time to freshen up before dinner. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: OXFORD



Monday, May 28TH - This morning we explore the beautiful city of Oxford, Astride the River Thames, its historic buildings are clustered within easy walking distance around the medieval core. The real treasure is the architectural beauty of Oxford University and its diverse buildings, many of which date back to the 13th and 14th centuries. Our tour will end with a visit to Christchurch, the largest of the Oxford colleges and home to the city's cathedral. The afternoon and evening are free. For dinner why not sample a local restaurant or pub (David knows a few from his student days here!). (B) OVERNIGHT: OXFORD

Tuesday, May 29TH - Leaving Oxford, we drive through the beautiful Cotswold Hills to Bath. After checking in to our hotel in Bath, this afternoon's walking tour introduces the historic city. Our first stop will be Bath Abbey, the last of the great English pre-Reformation churches, built in a pleasantly consistent late-perpendicular style. From the Abbey we walk across the piazza to the Roman Baths. These are some of the most extensive and best-preserved Roman remains in the state of the product of the state of the sta

in the country and the whole underground complex makes a fascinating visit. Dinner is included this evening. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: BATH





Thursday, May 31st - Our journey today will take us to Salisbury. We'll stop first, just outside Bath, at the small town of Bradford-upon-Avon and visit its wonderful Saxon church. Next comes a stop at the ancient, enigmatic monument of Stonehenge. We'll explore this World Heritage Site and then drive the short distance to the city of Salisbury. After checking into our hotel we'll stroll through the water meadows for a visit to Salisbury Cathedral. Dinner is included this evening. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: SALISBURY

STONEHENGE

FRIDAY, JUNE 1st - This morning we'll visit Wilton House, just outside of Salisbury, which ranks among the elite of British stately homes and is often described as "the loveliest house in England." The Double Cube Room was designed to display family portraits by Van Dyck, and it offers the greatest collection of paintings by the artist still to be seen in the finest surviving 17th-century stateroom in England. Twenty-one acres of gardens and park offer a superb setting for the house, one of the premier examples of Palladian architecture in Britain. The afternoon and evening are free to explore Salisbury: stroll the lovely medieval streets, visit the Antiques Center on Catherine Street, or attend evensong in the Cathedral. (B) OVERNIGHT: SALISBURY

SATURDAY, JUNE 2ND - A morning drive today brings us to the town of Windsor. We'll check in to our hotel and then head into the town. After free time for lunch, we'll visit Windsor Castle, the longest continuously inhabited royal residence in the world and a treasury of English history. A farewell dinner is at our hotel this evening. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR

SUNDAY, JUNE 3RD- Morning transfers to nearby Heathrow Airport for returning flights to the U.S. (B) OVERNIGHT: HOME

Key to included meals: **B** - breakfast, **L** - lunch, **D** - dinner

Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.
- 6. Conduct During The Tour: You are also responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and the laws of the countries in your itinerary. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

- 1. A deposit of \$500 must accompany this completed form, if it has not already been paid.
- 2. The remaining balance will be billed and payable 90 days prior to trip departure.

TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS

Discover Europe makes every effort to guarantee that the published cost of your chosen tour will not change. However, we do reserve the right to make adjustments in the following circumstances:

- Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
- 2. Group size. Your tour has been based on a minimum group size of 15 participants. Should we end up with fewer than 15 people, Discover Europe will determine a course of action which may involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour with all the inclusions listed, or making adjustments in order to keep the cost the same.
- 3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

REFUND POLICY

- 1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty.
- 2. Participants who withdraw fewer than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less the following cancellation penalties:

90-61 days prior to departure: \$1000 per person 60 - 31 days prior to departure: \$2000 per person Fewer than 30 days prior to departure: no refund

- 3. Please note that the final payment becomes due upon receipt of the final invoice and will remain payable, as per the above schedule, if your cancellation is received after this.
- 4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.
