WEDNESDAY, JUNE 8TH - Your morning arrival at Heathrow will be met by your Discover Europe representative. Early arrivals will transfer to nearby Waltham Place to visit the "natural garden" that is the brainchild of Strilli Oppenheimer. Later arrivals at the airport will be able to catch up with the group here for the transfer to our first hotel. Upon arrival, there will be time to unpack and rest up before we gather for a cocktail reception and dinner. (D) OVERNIGHT: TAUNTON

THURSDAY, JUNE 9TH - Heading west to the border of the county of Devon, we visit the fabulous medieval house of Cothay Manor. Twelve acres of magical gardens surround the manor. Many garden rooms, each a garden in itself, are set off a 200 yard yew walk. In addition there are fine trees, a cottage garden, courtyards, and a river walk; a plantsman's paradise. The gardens have achieved the highest accolade of two stars in the Good Garden Guide and in June 2012 featured in the Daily Telegraph's "20 Best Gardens in Britain." We will also have a guided tour of the house, one of the finest small medieval manor houses in the country, dating from the 14th century. This afternoon we pay a visit to Mapperton House, home of the Earl and Countess of Sandwich. The valley gardens at Mapperton reflect at least three periods of history. On the top level is the croquet lawn, where in dry weather the remains of a parterre, possibly 17th century, can be made out. On the next level is the Italianate garden laid out by Mrs Ethel Labouchere in her husband's memory in the 1920s, complete with grottoes, stone ornamental birds, animals and fountains. An orangery was added by Victor Montagu in the late 1960s, the current Earl of Sandwich's father. Below the wall and summer house are fish ponds which lead to the wild garden with its wonderful specimen shrubs and trees. Free evening in Yeovil. (B) **OVERNIGHT: TAUNTON**

FRIDAY, JUNE 10TH - Our first visit today will be to garden writer Margery Fish's archetypal cottage garden at East Lambrook. Margery Fish was the undisputed "Leading Lady of Gardening" from the 1950s and it was Margery's natural gift in bringing old-fashioned and contemporary plants together that has so dramatically influenced the way we garden today. This afternoon, by way of contrast, we will visit Forde Abbey Gardens. Originally a Cistercian Monastery, today Forde Abbey is a private home with over 30 acres of award-winning gardens. We'll have a tour of the house and gardens before



returning to our hotel for free time to explore and find a local restaurant or pub for dinner (B) **OVERNIGHT:** TAUNTON

SATURDAY, JUNE 11TH - A leisurely start this morning will take us first

to nearby Montacute House. We'll have time to explore the formal gardens, visit the Orangery and wander down the

Lime Avenue, before we turn our attention to the inside of the house. This beautiful Elizabethan country home was featured recently in the BBC production of Wolf Hall and also houses a part of the collection of the National Portrait


Gallery. Heading north, we'll stop for lunch in Glastonbury, a town forever associated with the legend of King Arthur. We'll pay a visit to the Abbey before continuing on to Milton Lodge Gardens for a private guided tour and tea. The evening is free. (B, T) **OVERNIGHT: TAUNTON**

WINDSOR

SUNDAY, JUNE 12TH - Leaving Yeovil, we head north and cross the Severn Bridge into the Principality of Wales. En route we'll stop for a private visit to Lady Farm in the village of

Chelwood. Lady Farm is the labour of love for the last 20 years of Malcom and Judy Pearce. Arriving in Wales, our first visit is to Veddw House Garden, the brainchild of garden writer Anne Wareham. Anne will give us a personal tour of her garden before we have to continue to our hotel in Llanelli, where dinner awaits. (B, D) **OVERNIGHT: LLANELLI**

Monday, June 13TH - We'll begin the day with a visit to Aberglasney House and Gardens. Spectacularly set



in the beautiful Tywi valley of Carmarthenshire, Aberglasney House features one of the finest gardens in Wales. Aberglasney Gardens have been an inspiration to poets since 1477. The story of Aberglasney spans many centuries, but the house's origins are still shrouded in obscurity. Our afternoon visit today is to the National Botanic Gardens of Wales, opened in May 2000 and now the most visited garden in Wales. We'll return to Llanelli for a free evening. (B) **Overnight: Llanelli**

TUESDAY, JUNE 14TH - We begin today with an excursion around St. David's Peninsula. Our first stop will be Picton castle, whose present gardens can be traced to the late 1800s. We'll visit the gardens and take a tour of the castle (providing that it is not being used for a private event). Continuing on around the peninsula we'll visit the cathedral of St. David, the patron saint of Wales and stop in Britain's smallest city for lunch. This afternoon we'll visit Dyffryn Fernant garden. Staring with a complete wilderness in 1996, Christina Shand has created a modern Welsh garden and will delight in taking us on a tour of her masterpiece. There may be time to stop at the Neolithic site of Pentre Ifan on the way back to Llanelli this evening. (B) **OVERNIGHT: LLANELLI**

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15TH - Driving north through Pembrokeshire this morning we head for Caer Hir, a "Dutch garden in the heart of Wales." And you'll have to join our tour to solve that riddle! On the return journey to Llanelli, we'll stop at Laugharne

and pay our respects to a Welsh national treasure, the poet Dylan Thomas. It was in the boathouse at Laugharne that he wrote many of his most famous works. From Laugharne we

head into the city of Swansea, where we'll visit Dylan Thomas' house and have free time for shopping. Free evening in Llanelli. (B) **OVERNIGHT: LLANELLI**

Thursday, June 16TH - We leave south Wales today and head back along the motorway and across the River Severn back into England. Our destination is the Royal town of Windsor, but on the way, we'll stop for a guided tour of the gardens of Cliveden, the fabulous home of William Waldorf Astor. We'll end the day with a sumptuous farewell dinner at our hotel in Windsor. (B, D) **OVERNIGHT: BURNHAM**

FRIDAY, JUNE 17TH - Morning transfers to Heathrow Airport for returning flights to the U.S. (B) **OVERNIGHT: HOME**

1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.

Should we end up with less than 10 people, Discover Europe will work with Marian St Clair to determine a course of action which will involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour as is, or making adjustments to the tour in order to keep the cost the same.

REFUND POLICY
