

Mallorca

July 9th - 17th 2019

A shining jewel set in a silver sea, the island of Mallorca lies in the Mediterranean off the east coast of Spain. Though politically part of Spain, the local inhabitants are fiercely independent and regard themselves as Mallorquin first and Spanish second, speaking their own native dialect in addition to Spanish.

The island is at once small enough to be easily manageable, but large enough to provide a variety of landscapes and resources. From the mountains of the northwest to the fertile central plain, there is an abundance of historical and artistic treasure to occupy the discerning visitor. And of course, you will get to visit the beautiful beaches that are beloved of European tourists in the summer months.

The College of New Jersey has offered graduate level summer courses in Mallorca since 1981, serving teachers and administrators who work at some of the world's finest international schools. Currently classes are held at Bellver International College, on the south shore of the island, near the Marivent Palace where King Felipe VI and his family spend their summers.

Our base for the first part of the trip, will be the historic town of Soller, set in the beautiful Tramuntana Mountains. Soller is accessible to the capital, Palma, by a wonderful antique electric train that affords incredible views as it weaves up through the

mountains and out the other side. The second part of the trip we will be based in the capital, Palma, near the TCNJ summer campus, with opportunities for tour participants to interact with current Mallorca program students.

We will be guided throughout by local resident Gavin Miller. English by birth, after attending Cambridge University, Gavin made his home on the island, where he runs a local

theatre company and leads tours.

Tuesday, July 9TH - Departure from your chosen US gateway city. Over-NIGHT: PLANE

WEDNESDAY, JULY 10TH - Morning arrival in Palma, Mallorca where you will be met for the transfer to our hotel in Soller. The rest of the day is free to unpack and relax from the flights. Dinner is included at the hotel this evening. (D) OVERNIGHT: SOLLER

Thursday, July 11TH - Today, after a leisurely breakfast, Gavin will take those interested to the beautiful village of Deia, nestled in the mountains south of Soller. We'll have time to climb up to the church and visit the grave of the poet, Robert Graves,

who made the village his home for many years. We'll continue to nearby Valldemossa and the Carthusian Monastery that was home to Frederick Chopin and Georges Sand in the winter of 1838-9. After free time for lunch, we'll travel south for a view of spectacular coastal scenery before returning to Soller. The evening is free to sample the wonderful family-run

restaurants around the main square. (B) OVERNIGHT: SOLLER

FRIDAY JULY 12TH - Today is a free day in Soller. In the evening we will head to Palma, for a poolside Meet and Greet with students currently in TCNJ's graduate global programs. (B) OVERNIGHT: SOLLER

SATURDAY, JULY 13TH - Our excursion today takes us to the southeast corner of the island. Beginning with the charming fishing village of Portocolom, we'll have time to stroll the waterfront or sit and have coffee in one of the harborside cafes. Lunch will be included at the nearby mountaintop monastery of San Salvador – the best paella on the island. After lunch, we will drive back across the island via the town of Petra, where we visit the Birthplace Museum of Junipero de Serra, a Franciscan friar who established a string of missions along




the coast of California. We continue to Soller for a free evening. (B, L) OVERNIGHT: SOLLER

SUNDAY, JULY 14TH - After breakfast we will transfer to our hotel in Palma and have a free day in this beautiful city. You might like to visit Bellver Castle, shop in the cobblestone alleys off the Passeig de Born or have tapas in the Medieval La Llotja neighborhood. (B) OVERNIGHT: PALMA

Monday, July 15th - Today Gavin will show us the highlights of Palma. We'll take a walking tour of the historic center that includes the fabulous Gothic cathedral, known as "La Seu," and the Moorish Palacio de la Almudaina, with beautiful gardens featuring a Calder mobile. There will be free time for lunch in the Santa Catalina market area, then we are invited attend the TED CNJ presentations by students and faculty in the TCNJ Mallorca program. (B) OVERNIGHT: PALMA


Tuesday, July 16TH - This morning we'll visit the Monastery of Lluc, which has been a center of pilgrimage since the 13th century when an Arab shepherd boy, newly converted to Christianity, discovered a dark wooden statue of the Virgin



in a cleft in the rock. The image was placed in the local church but three times it returned miraculously to its cave, whereupon the villagers built the monastery to house it. Descending, we'll stop in the charming village of Pollenca for lunch before heading back to Palma. We will have dinner at the traditional Mallorquin restaurant C'an Pedro de Genova, with views of the Tramuntana Mountains and Palma Bay. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: PALMA

Wednesday, July 17TH - Alas, all good things must come to an end, and this morning we transfer back to Palma Airport for return flights to the US. **(B)**

Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.
- 6. Conduct During the Tour: You are also responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and the laws of the countries in your itinerary. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

- 2. The remaining balance will be billed and payable 90 days prior to trip departure.

TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS

Discover Europe makes every effort to guarantee that the published cost of your chosen tour will not change. However, we do reserve the right to make adjustments in the following circumstances:

1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of

- the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
- 2. Group size. This tour has been based on a group size of 15 participants. Should we end up with less than this, Discover Europe will work with The College of New Jersey to determine a course of action which will involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour as is, or making adjustments to the tour in order to keep the cost the same.
- 3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

REFUND POLICY

- 1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty per person.
- 2. Participants who withdraw fewer than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less the following cancellation penalties:
 - 90-61 days prior to departure: \$1000 per person
 - 60 31 days prior to departure: \$2000 per person
 - Fewer than 30 days prior to departure: no refund
- 3. Please note that the final payment becomes due upon receipt of the final invoice and will remain payable, as per the above schedule, if your cancellation is received after this.
- 4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.
- 5. Trip cancellation insurance is not included in your Discover Europe tour package. Discover Europe, Ltd., strongly advises that you purchase travel insurance for your upcoming trip. Information describing the services of a recommended travel insurance company will be made available to you upon registration.
- 6. All cancellation requests must be received in writing.
- 7. There is no provision for refund for any activities missed due to the participant's absence once the tour has started.
