
The legendary beauty of the French Riviera has beckoned visitors for centuries. Artists have been inspired by its brilliant light and deep shadows, poets and writers have been moved to pen great works and holidaymakers, from the very rich and famous to everyday travellers, have come to bask in the sunshine and glamour that this coastline offers.

This fall, join the Barrington Community School on an unforgettable exploration of the art and culture of the French Cote d'Azur. We'll make our first base in the city of Hyeres, within easy striking distance of the city of Marseilles and the fabulous scenery of the Luberon, the mountainous National Park that rises above the coastal plain of Provence. We'll also spend a day exploring Porquerolles, one the Iles de Hyeres, just off the coast.

We then move on to the exotic city of Nice, where panoramic sightseeing will introduce the vastly different areas of the city. We include a visit to the world-famous Matisse Museum as well. Day excursions from Nice capture the contrast of the magnificent scenery – coastal and mountainous – which surround the city. Highlights will certainly be our visits to Renoir's house and garden, the Picasso Museum and the extravagant 19th-century estate of the Baroness de Rothschild.

Your traveling party will be escorted by BCS Director, Sandi Tinyk and Discover Europe's Gavin Miller as they once again join forces to lead you through scenic landscapes and ancient towns on this customized tour that has been designed exclusively for BCS.

MEALS:



THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 19TH - This afternoon we leave Barrington and take our private bus to Logan Airport, where we board British Airways' overnight flight to London, connecting with the onward service to Nice. **Overnight: Plane**

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 20TH - Your arrival at Nice Airport will be met for the transfer to our hotel in Hyeres. We'll check in to our hotel and there will be free time to find lunch and begin exploring the neighborhood. This afternoon we will have a chance to unpack and rest up from the flights. This evening we will gather for dinner at the hotel. (D) Overnight: Hyeres

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 21^{sr} - This morning we head into Marseilles. A panoramic tour of the vibrant city will soon rid you of any notions of the *French Connection* that may linger! From the Old Port to the castle that inspired the Count of Monte Cristo, a local guide will introduce us to the highlights of the city. There will be free time for lunch and for individual exploration before we return to Hyeres for a free evening. **(B) Overnight: Hyeres**

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 22ND - Today we journey north into the beautiful Luberon region, an area composed of rolling hills, hilltop drystone villages and spectacular countryside of vineyards and orchards, so colorfully depicted by Peter Mayles in his best-seller, *A Year in Provence*. Our first stop will be l'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue, where we can stroll the riverside and browse local antique shops, art galleries,



boutiques and cafés. We then continue to Gordes, widely considered one of France's most beautiful villages, and Bonnieux, a lovely village known for its medieval Roman-Gothic Vielle Église. From here, we'll follow the Combe of Lourmarin, a verdant river valley that splits the Luberon mountain range. We'll stop in the picturesque town of Lourmarin for lunch and to view the town's Renaissance castle, dubbed the Villa Medicis de Provence. After lunch, we visit the medieval Sénanque Abbey and marvel at its architectural splendor. Our final stop is the hilltop town of Roussillon for an unforgettable look at the region's famous ochre cliffs, painted in swathes of red and yellow. We return to Hyeres for a free evening. **(B) Overnight: Hyeres**

Monday, September 23RD - A short drive this morning brings us to the coast at La Tour Fondue, where we take the short (20 minute) ferry ride over to the island of Porquerolles. Arriving at the Port of Porquerolles, it is a short, 15-minute walk (no cars are allowed on the island) to the new contemporary art museum recently opened by the Fondation Carmignac. After taking a tour of the museum, we'll head back into the town center where there are many options for lunch. The afternoon is free to explore the many craft stores or to visit the 16th-century Fort St. Agathe. Later in the afternoon we'll return by ferry to the mainland and then to our hotel, where we will have time to relax before dinner. (B, D) Overnight: Hyeres

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24TH - Leaving Hyeres, we'll drive along the coast to the playground of the wealthy, St. Tropez. We'll stop for coffee and to walk around the town before we continue to Cannes. After free time for lunch, we continue to the town of Le Cannet, above the city, where we visit the relatively new museum dedicated to the work of the painter Pierre Bonnard. We then drive to Antibes for a late afternoon visit to the Picasso Museum, perched on a cliff overlooking the Mediterranean. We continue on to our hotel in Nice, where dinner is included this evening. (B, D) Overnight: Nice

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25TH - After a leisurely breakfast, panoramic sightseeing introduces the glories of Nice: la Place Garibaldi, la Place Masa, les Boulevard des Etats-Unis and the Promenade des Anglais – the very names evoke the international



flavor of this city! We'll end our tour at Cimiez, on the hill overlooking the city. Here we'll see the remains of the old Roman city and visit the Matisse Museum. We head back down into the city center where a visit to the Chagall Museum is included. The afternoon is free to wander through the narrow, cobbled streets of the old town. The evening is free to explore one of Nice's excellent restaurants or cafes. (B) Overnight: Nice

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 26TH - An excursion from Nice today takes us up into the mountains, the Alpes Maritimes, behind the city. We'll visit the towns of Vence and St. Paul (also known as St. Paul de Vence) which have been made famous by their associations with artists throughout the last hundred years. Marc Chagall

lived here and we'll pay a visit to the Matisse Chapel. We'll also visit the contemporary art museum, the Fondation Maeght, and have free time to wander the village streets and have a leisurely lunch before returning to Nice for a free evening. (B) Overnight: Nice

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 27TH - Our day begins in style at the extravagant gardens of the Villa Ephrussi de Rothschild. Created for Beatrix de Rothschild, the themed gardens (Spanish, Italian, and Japanese) occupy one of the most beautiful points on the peninsula of St-Jean-Cap-Ferrat. We'll visit the villa as well, furnished in the grandest 18th-century French style. After lunch we leave the coast for a visit to Eze, an ancient village perched on the summit of a pyramidal rock. We return to Nice for our farewell dinner (B, D) Overnight: Nice

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28TH - You may have time this morning for a little last-minute shopping before we transfer to Nice Airport for the short British Airways flight to London to connect with our transatlantic flight to Boston. Our private transport will meet the flight for the journey back to Barrington. (B) Overnight: Home

TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS

- 1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the Euro by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
- 2. Group size. This tour has been based on a group size of 15 participants. Should we end up with less than 15 people, Discover Europe will work with Barrington Community School to determine a course of action which will involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour as is, or making adjustments to the tour in order to keep the cost the same.
- 3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

REFUND POLICY

- 1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty.
- 2. Participants who withdraw fewer than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less the following cancellation penalties:

90-61 days prior to departure: \$1000 per person

60 days - trip departure: no refund (unless traveler has insurance)

- 3. Please note that the final payment becomes due upon receipt of the final invoice and will remain payable, as per the above schedule, if your cancellation is received after this.
- 4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.
