# Culinary Adventures with Chef Victor Beguin

## SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup> - OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> 2020

The village of Camon is set in the foothills of the Pyrenees, on a bend of the river Hers, in the Ariege region of southern France. Together with the neighboring departments of Aude and Pyrenees-Orientales, it forms an area commonly known as Cathar Country.

It is a region with a fierce sense of independence and a long memory. It has been 800 years since the Albigensian Crusade was launched against the heretic Cathars, but it has never been forgotten. In the 12th century, this area of France was not really under the control of the King in Paris at all and the people spoke a different language. At that time the word for "yes" in northern France was "oil." Down here in the south, it was "oc" – hence this area is also known as the Languedoc (le langue d'oc means, literally,



the language of yes). Just recently, in 2016, the French government reorganized the official regions of France and, in a tip of the hat to its historic past, renamed the combined regions of Languedoc-Rousillon and Midi-Pyrenees, as Occitanie – the place where they speak Occitan.

It is a region of incredible natural beauty. The majestic Pyrenees march down to the fertile valley of the Canal du Midi and the high mountain pastures, with their unbelievable variety of dairy products, give way to endless vineyards, producing such wonderful wines as Corbieres and Minervois. This tour has been designed to explore, not only the history of the area, but also to immerse you in the wonderful food and wine of the region - an amazing variety of locally-produced artisanal cheeses, organic wines, fresh breads and pastries, and locally-sourced meats and vegetables. Market day is truly a feast for the senses!

With the Château de Camon as our base for a week, we will explore the gastronomy of the region under the expert tutelage of Chef Victor Beguin and be immersed in its history, from the ruins of Cathar castles to the medieval grandeur of Carcassonne, in the company of Discover Europe's president, Michael Induni.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup> - Departure from your US gateway city. Overnight: Plane


**THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24™** - Your arrival in Toulouse will be met by Discover Europe's representative for the short (one and a half hour) drive to the Château. The rest of the day is free to unpack, relax and begin exploring the neighborhood. This evening the group will gather on the terrace for drinks before a welcome dinner party. **(D) Overnight: Camon** 

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25<sup>TH</sup> - A leisurely start this morning, to shake off the effects of the long flights. We'll take a stroll around the village, known as the Village of Roses, and visit the abbey church, before we set off on our excursion. Our first stop will be to the Domaine Gayda, a local vineyard owned and operated by the head vintner, Tim Ford. We'll have lunch in the restaurant here, with

fabulous views out over the Pyrenees, and then Tim will give us a tour of the facility and end with a tasting of his delicious creations. Next, a short drive through the heavenly Ariège countryside brings us to the magical Romanesque Abbey of St. Hilaire - the birthplace of sparkling wine! We return to Camon to dine at the Château again this evening. **(B, L, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON** 

Saturday, September 26<sup>TH</sup> - Today we head up into the Pyrenees. Our first stop will be the forest of Belesta, where a local expert will introduce us to the joys of mushrooming. Next, we'll visit the village of Montaillou, famous as the last enclave of the persecuted Cathars. Here we'll take an easy hike around the ruins of the Chateau and then stop for lunch at the Col de Chioula, with some of the most magnificent views that a restaurant could wish for! We then descend to visit the spa town of Ax-les-Thermes, before returning to the hotel. This evening chef Victor will give a demonstration of various things we can do with fresh mushrooms! The results will be delicious and form the basis of our dinner this evening. (B, L, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 27<sup>TH</sup> - This morning, we visit the nearby archaeological site of Teilhet to see the Merovingian Necropolis of Tabariane, discovered in 1870 and excavated in 1998. Leaving this site, we go to the neighboring village of Vals to visit the fascinating Eglise Rupestre (Trogladyte Church) and have lunch in Café Vals. This afternoon we will pay a visit to a local sheep farm to see the production of the Brebis (hard sheep cheeses) for which the region is famous. On our return to Camon, there will be time to relax by the pool or enjoy a cocktail on the terrace before dinner at the Chateau. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON



Monday, September 28<sup>TH</sup> - After a leisurely breakfast on the terrace, overlooking the lovely gardens set against the distant Pyrenean peaks, a three mile journey will bring us to Mirepoix on market day. There will be time to explore one of France's most exquisite medieval squares, and enjoy a coffee at one of the many cafes. After lunch, we will head for Montsegur. The ruined castle, set high on a rocky crag, was the final refuge of the persecuted Cathars. In 1244 the Catholic Church carried out one of its worst ever atrocities; 225 Cathars, who refused to recant, were burnt on a communal pyre. There will be time to make the ascent to the castle (30 minutes), for those who enjoy a hike, and for those with nothing to prove, a wonderful respite to take in the views and reflect on the horrors of the past! On returning to the hotel there will be time to relax and enjoy a cocktail on the terrace, before Chef Victor gives us another demonstration of his skills - no doubt based upon what looked enticing at the market this morning! (B, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON

Tuesday, September 29<sup>TH</sup> - Our first stop this morning will be the bio-dynamic vineyard of Chateau Maris. We have a tour of the cellars and taste the delightful product before we have lunch (included). This afternoon we visit Carcassonne. If you had to choose one medieval fortress town to visit, Carcassonne would be it. Restored to perfection, you only need imagine fellow travelers dressed in sackcloth, doublet and hose, and you're back in the medieval world! We will visit the beautiful St. Nazaire church with some of the loveliest stained glass in France. There will be time to tour the inner fortress, Château Comtal, and wander the narrow alleyways, before we return to Camon for dinner. (B, L, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON


WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TM</sup> - This morning we'll head to the mountain-top village of Rennes-le-Château. A visit to the parish church will either spark or rejuvenate your interest in Dan Brown's mysteries. The church is full of symbols and secret codes which may indicate that Abbé Saunière, the priest from 1885 to 1910, had discovered the lost treasure of Solomon, brought to the region by the Visigoths in

the 5<sup>th</sup> century. We'll have time here for lunch before a beautiful drive takes us back home, stopping in Puivert on the way. Relatively intact for a Cathar castle, Puivert is in a wonderful position overlooking the surrounding countryside. Time permitting, we'll also visit the Museum of Quercorb (the local name for the surrounding area) in the village. This evening we get to watch as Chef Victor prepares our farewell feast. **(B, D) OVERNIGHT: CAMON** 

**THURSDAY, OCTOBER 1**<sup>st</sup> - Reluctantly we will bid farewell to the abbey this morning and head back to Toulouse Airport for flights back to the US. **(B)**
