

This year we are exploring some new territory - a region that not that many tourists find their way to - the *Backroads of Northern Britain*.


We'll begin in the north of England. Flying into Manchester Airport, our first stop is in the City of York, a beautifully preserved medieval city complete with it's original city walls. We'll explore the city, and spend a day at nearby Castle Howard.

Moving further north we hit the wild and lawless border region (not really any more - but it used to be). The large fortified castles of the area bear testament to the times when an invasion by the Scots was an everyday fear. Lying right on the border, the town of Berwickupon-Tweed has changed hands between England and Scotland 17 times!

Finally, we spend time in the Scottish Lowlands and the capital, Edinburgh - but with an excursion into the beginning of the Highlands around Loch Lomond.

We'll stay in lovely hotels, gaze in wonder at breathtaking scenery, hear tales of long-dead saints and heros and marvel at ancient castles and extravagant palaces. Join Judy and David again this year for another "best trip ever!" as we explore the *Backroads* of Northern Britain.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 3RD - Departure from your chosen US gateway city. OVERNIGHT: PLANE


FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4^m - Your morning arrival at Manchester Airport will be met for the transfer to our hotel near Leeds. Please ensure that you arrive **no later than 12.00 pm**, as the ride to our hotel in York will take around 2 hours. This afternoon we will have a chance to unpack and rest up from the overnight flight, and begin exploring the city. This evening we will gather for cocktails at the hotel. **OVERNIGHT: YORK**

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5TH - A full day's exploration of the medieval jewel that is the City of York. A guided tour of the exquisite York Minster this morning is followed by a visit to the Treasurer's House where we will have a private tour of the cellars, which are supposedly haunted by the ghosts of the Ninth Legion. York is full of fabulous museums from the Jorvik Center, which recreates the Viking history of the town, to the Castle Museum which houses a remarkable collection of Victorian items. The afternoon is free to sample them at your own pace; you also have a free evening in York to explore its pubs and restaurants. **(B) OVERNIGHT: YORK**


SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6TH - This morning, it's a short journey to Castle Howard, immediately recognizable from the BBC television series, Brideshead Revisted. This 18th-century Vanbrugh

masterpiece and its fine collection of Old Masters will enthrall as we take a private VIP tour of the house before it is open to the general public. Time to lunch on your own in one of the estate's three restaurants before returning to York for a free afternoon. Perhaps a visit to the acclaimed Railway Museum or a stroll through the Museum Gardens. Climb the old castle keep, known as Clifford's Tower, or explore the shops on Stonegate. The evning is also free. **(B) OVERNIGHT: YORK**

MONDAY, OCTOBER 7^{m} - Heading up the Great North Road today, we arrive in the ancient city of Durham. The River Wear flows around the city's center, adding to its picturesque beauty, which is dominated by Durham Cathedral, founded in 1093 and generally regarded as one of the finest examples of Norman architecture in Europe (also a UNESCO World Heritage Site). After time for lunch, we continue north to Alnwick Castle, where we will tour the award-winning garden. Created by the visionary Duchess of Northumberland, and considered by many to be one of the most exciting contemporary gardens in the last 100 years, Alnwick is truly a 21st-century garden. It is a short distance from here to our hotel. (B) **OVERNIGHT: ALNWICK**



TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8TH - After a leisurely start this morning, we drive to nearby Lindisfarne, also called Holy Island, the home of the religious community established by St. Cuthbert. Durham Cathedral was founded by monks from the Abbey at Lindisfarne. We have



to time our visit around the incoming tides, as the island causeway is cut off from the mainland at high tide. Later this afternoon we return to our hotel for a free evening. **(B) OVERNIGHT: ALNWICK**

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9TH - Today we enjoy a panorama of the Scottish Lowlands. We'll begin in Jedburgh with a visit to the fantastic 12th-century ruins of Jedburgh Abbey. We'll then have free time in the town for lunch, and a possible visit to Mary Queen of Scots' house. This afternoon we visit Abbotsford, the country home of Sir Walter Scott, the 19th-century novelist and 'Great Scott' who popularised tartan, saved the Scottish banknote and rediscovered his country's Crown Jewels! Time permitting, we'll make a stop at Melrose Abbey on our way back to our hotel. (B) OVERNIGHT: ALNWICK

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10TH - Following the coast road north this morning, our first stop will be to the Glenkinchie Distillery at Tranent. We'll take the tour and have a chance to sample this wonderful single malt whisky before we continue on to Roslyn Chapel. We'll stop for lunch at a country pub along the way before we take a tour of the chapel, made famous by the novels of Dan Brown. Skirting Edinburgh, we'll then head to our hotel in Gleneagles. **(B) OVERNIGHT: GLENEAGLES**

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 11TH - An excursion today into the lower Highlands. We head west from Gleneagles into the area of outstanding natural beauty known as The Trossachs. We'll pass by Rob Roy's cave and drive along the shores of Loch Lomond. This afternoon we'll pay a visit to Drummond Castle Gardens, or perhaps the Glenturret Distillery in Crieff, on our way back to Gleneagles. **(B) OVERNIGHT: GLENEAGLES**

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12^m - On our way to Edinburgh this morning, our first stop will be the beautiful grounds of the famous St. Andrews Golf Course. We will have time here to explore and get some souvenirs before heading on to lunch at the Tavern Eatery. We'll arrive in the capital late-afternoon to settle into our hotel. **(B) OVERNIGHT: EDINBURGH**

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13TH - The elegant city of Edinburgh is the political and cultural capital of Scotland. Set atop seven volcanic hills, it brims with historic treasures, but its finest is surely Edinburgh Castle, a towering fortification that dominates the skyline. Morning sightseeing with a local guide includes magnificent views from Calton Hill and a visit to the historic castle, where you can admire the Honours of Scotland, her crown jewels. You'll have a free afternoon and evening to explore the city and sample one of its many fine restaurants. **(B) OVERNIGHT: EDINBURGH**

MONDAY, OCTOBER 14TH - A free day in Edinburgh. This morning David will lead an optional tour to visit the Royal Yacht *Britannia*, which lies in the Port of Leith since it was decommissioned. You will be able to explore at your leisure with your own personal audio guide. **(B) OVERNIGHT: EDINBURGH**


TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15TH - A final free day in the city to visit some of the many attractions available or to do some last-minute shopping. **(B) OVERNIGHT: EDINBURGH**

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16^m - Morning transfers to Edinburgh Airport for return flights to the USA. **(B) OVERNIGHT: HOME**

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30TH - Departure from your US gateway city. OVERNIGHT: PLANE



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TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1^{sr} - Individual arrivals will be met and transferred to our riverside hotel in the nearby town of Windsor. The rest of the day is free to unpack, relax and start to shake off the effects of jet-lag. **OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR**

WEDENESDAY, OCTOBER 2ND - Our day begins with a guided tour of Windsor Castle, the largest occupied castle in the world. A royal home and fortress for over 900 years, the castle remains a working palace. We'll tour the state apartments, an extensive suite of rooms at the heart of the palace, where furnishings include treasures from the Royal Collection—paintings by Holbein, Rubens, Van Dyck, and Lawrence; fine tapestries and porcelain; and sculptures. The afternoon and evening are free to explore the town and sample a local restaurant. (B) OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 3RD - It's a short drive this morning, by private coach, to Hampton Court Palace. Here, we'll explore the gardens, state apartments, and Tudor kitchens, and have time for lunch before returning to our hotel. On our return to Windsor, the rest of the day is free. (B) OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4TH - This morning you return to nearby Heathrow Airport for the short flight to Manchester, where we will meet up with other members of our group arriving from the US and transfer to our hotel in the Leeds area. **(B) OVERNIGHT: LEEDS AREA**

This includes 3 nights' accommodation at a first class hotel, breakfast daily, DE tour guide David Phillips throughout, all entrance fees and transportation as detailed in the itinerary, one way flight from London to Manchester (in business class) and baggage handling of one large suitcase per person.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Make checks payable to DISCOVER EUROPE, LTD.

2. Detach the bottom section and mail it to Discover Europe with your registration payment of \$500 per person. The remaining balance will be billed and payable 90 days prior to trip departure.

3. Please make sure that your name appears on this form exactly as it does on your passport.

4. Please be sure to complete both sides of this form.

5. Space on this journey is limited and registrations are accepted strictly on a first come, first served basis.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. Registration and payment imply acceptance of the terms and conditions described herein. This information, as well as your itinerary description regarding dates, inclusions and prices, form the basis of your individual contract with Discover Europe, Ltd.

2. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

4. Discover Europe, Ltd. reserves the right to substitute hotels, airlines, activities or excursions in response to changes in availability, local events or weather conditions, provided such substitutions do not adversely affect the overall quality of the tour. Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.

REFUND POLICY:

1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty.

2. Participants who withdraw less than 90 but more than 60 days prior to the day of their trip departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$2000 cancellation penalty.

3. Participants who withdraw less than 60 days prior to trip departure will not receive a refund.

4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.

5. Comprehensive travel insurance, including cancellation coverage, is NOT included in your tour package. Discover Europe strongly advises you to purchase comprehensive coverage and we will provide information on a recommended insurance company with your registration confirmation.

6. All cancellation requests must be received in writing.

7. There is no provision for refund for any activities missed due to the participant's absence once the tour has started.
